TAMPA: The University of South Florida Police Department will host a Sobriety Checkpoint on the USF Campus beginning at 2:30 a.m. on February 22, 2009, and lasting until 3:30 a.m. on February 22, 2009. During this time, USF Police Officers will use the Sobriety Checkpoint to identify impaired drivers in an effort to keep our streets safe. Impaired drivers that are identified will face arrest and prosecution. This operation is part of a comprehensive, collaborative approach to traffic safety by the USF Police Department.
